



## **2024 FNQGA JUNIOR REPRESENTATIVE PLAYER'S**

### **Introduction:**

1. Each year clubs within the FNQ region conducts Junior Opens.
2. The FNQGA selects a team of Junior Boys to participate in the Gary Player Classic each year.
3. The Gary Player Classic is an Australian Boys' Ranking Event open to male golfers under the age of 21 years and is played over 72-holes stroke play in three age divisions:
  - a. 15 Years and under,
  - b. 16 - 17 Years, and
  - c. 18 - 20 Years.

### **Selection for the FNQ Junior Team:**

4. The team is selected from junior players who have participated in Junior Open Tournaments conducted throughout the FNQ Region.
5. Selected Juniors must have current GA Handicaps, and must be members of a golf club which is affiliated with FNQGA. The following tournament handicap limits for age division are below.
  - a. 15 Years & Under – GA Handicap limit 18.4,
  - b. 16 -17 Years – GA Handicap limit 10.4, and
  - c. 18 - 20 Years – GA Handicap limit 6.4.
6. The FNQGA will select a team of three – four Junior Boys to participate in Gary Player Classic, the selection will be based the Juniors gross score from each Junior Open they play in. No Junior tournament is compulsory.
7. The selection series will be conducted over a 12-month period. Starting from 1<sup>st</sup> July Current year and ends on 30<sup>th</sup> June the following year.
8. Selection will be based on points awarded for Gross scores at each Junior Open and the Gary Player Classic handicap limitations for each age group:  
  
1st 50 pts, 2nd 45 pts, 3rd 40, 4th 35 pts, 5th 30 pts, 6th 25 pts, 7th 20 pts, 8th 15 pts, 9th 10,

9. Two bonus points will be awarded for attendants at each Junior open.
10. Players need to play a minimum of five Junior Opens to be considered for selection and must meet the handicap requirement for the tournament.
11. The selected Juniors will be informed of their selection by email after the last Junior open in June
12. All selected Juniors and Manager are expected to support each other throughout the tournament.

**Player Support:**

12. FNQGA provides each member of the Gary Player team with:

- a) Travel expenses (flights),
- b) Accommodation - team members are required to share a room.
- c) The district team uniform shirt, embroidered with (FNQ Gary Player Classic Team),
- d) Oversize Luggage (golf bag),
- e) Team vehicle(s), and
- f) Meals.

13. Not covered by FNQGA.

- a) Pocket money, and
- b) Push buggies.

14. The Team will be accompanied by Team Officials who have been issued with a Blue Card by the Queensland Department of Justice and Attorney General.
